Guiding us through this cinematic stroll down memory lane is our host extraordinaire, **Paul "Indiana Jones" Muraco**, who embraced this ambitious

project with enthusiasm and flair. 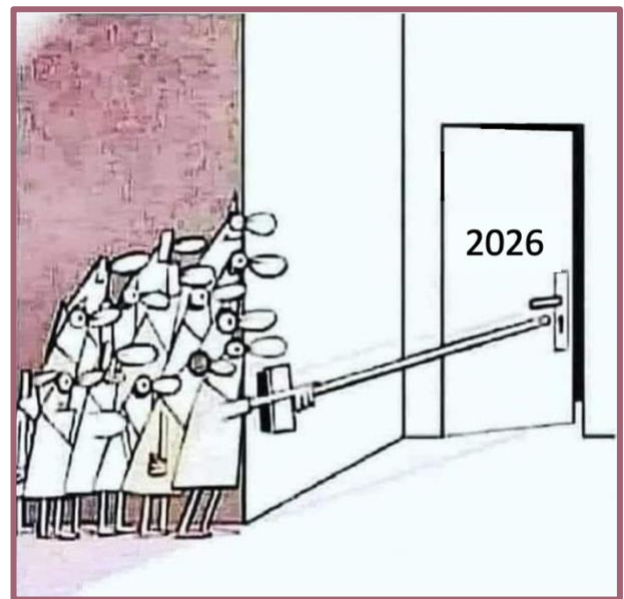
Unfortunately, at this time we do not have a full slate of candidates for the officer positions: **President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.**

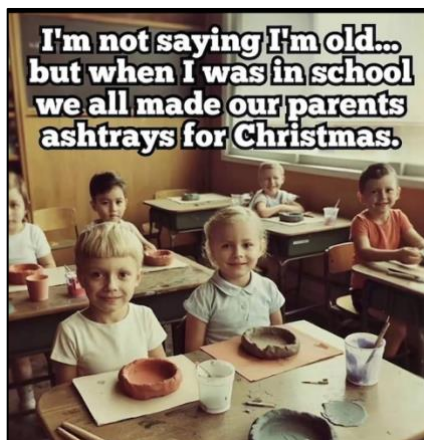

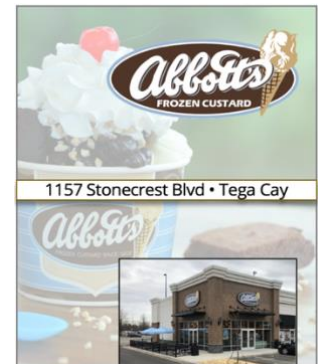
